

Described and Captioned Media Program (DCMP)

The DCMP provides services to benefit students who are blind, visually impaired, deaf, hard of hearing, or deaf-blind by offering:

- A free-loan library of described and captioned educational media that is available to students, school personnel, and families. Some media is available in Spanish.
- Information, available to everyone, related to accessible media.
- Guidelines and assistance for anyone wanting to learn how to add captions and/or description to educational media.

The DCMP Library

- The DCMP provides a library of free-loan described and captioned educational media for Early Learners through Grade 12. These materials are available through DVD and Internet streaming.
- DCMP streamed educational media will work on your favorite Apple or Android devices, as well as on your TV or projector using a streaming device such as Roku or Chromecast.
- Families, school personnel, and others with students who are blind, visually impaired, deaf, hard of hearing, or deaf-blind may apply for a free membership.

Information on Accessible Media

- The DCMP provides a learning center of information related to educational media access, which provides answers to questions, such as: (1) What is description? (2) How can I find someone to add captioning and/or description to my educational media? (3) What accessible educational media titles are available for loan or purchase?
- The DCMP is a gateway to Internet resources related to accessibility. Performing a search on the DCMP website will generate results from the DCMP site, information clearinghouse, and accessible media database, as well as results from other educational and consumer websites.
- The DCMP provides guidelines for anyone who captions and/or describes educational media.
- Anyone can use these services at no cost.
