With School Readiness assistance, they pay about 7%.

- There are approximately 1.3 million children younger than age 6 in Florida.
- About 49 percent of those children are from low-income families. Of this 49 percent, approximately 25 percent were in the School Readiness Program.
- In 2014-2015, 215,823 children received school readiness services from 9,195 providers.
