

Training for Child Care Educators

4C is the Training Coordinating Agency, one of 14 in the state, covering Orange, Osceola, Seminole and Brevard Counties. Training requirements are administered by the Department of Children and Families. Educators interested in working in child care must take mandated classes and pass exams for each class. Classes are offered online or with an instructor. Exams are taken in person. Fees apply to classes and exams.

To work as a Family Child Care Home provider, 30 hours of state mandated training are required with a passing exam.

Did you know?

Employees working in a child care center must complete 40 hours of state mandated training started within 90 days of employment and complete training, with a passing exam, within one year. An additional 5 hour Early Literacy and Language Development is required within one year and 10 hours of in-service training each year after.
