MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) BETWEEN COMMUNITY COORDINATED CARE FOR CHILDREN, INC. AND CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE OF ALLIED & TECHNOLOGY

This Memorandum of Understanding, (herein after referred to as "MOU") is entered into between COMMUNITY COORDINATED CARE FOR CHILDREN, INC., herein after referred to as "4C" and CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE OF ALLIED & TECHNOLOGY herein after referred to as "CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE".

This MOU is executed and entered into in the State of Florida, and shall be construed, performed, and enforced in all respects in accordance with the laws, rules, and regulations of the State of Florida. Each party shall perform its obligations herein in accordance with the terms and conditions of this MOU.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

This MOU is for use of 4C Early Head Start, Head Start and CCP sites listed in ATTACHMENT 1 that is part of this MOU for student medical services. This medical services will be offered by CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE to enhance their skills and abilities both in theory and practical training of health care personnel.

TERMS OF MOU

The effective date of this MOU is <u>upon execution</u> by both parties until June 30, 2019. 4C will have the option to renew these services for <u>two (2) additional term(s)</u> upon written notification to CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE prior to termination of the initial term. Renewal options are as follows:

Renewal #1: July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020 Renewal #2: July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021

CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE AGREES TO:

- 1) Provide 4C with a copy of a current professional license.
- 2) Provide adequate liability insurance coverage of at least \$1,000,000 on a comprehensive basis to hold such liability insurance at all times during the existence of this **MOU** and any renewal (s) and extension(s) of it. **4C** shall be named as additional insured.
- 3) Provide proof of current *Workers' Compensation Insurance* as required by law on all parties working for **CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE**, whether as employees, leased employees, temporary laborers, or sub-contractors on job site.
- 4) CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE will have a competent third party vendor that is approved by 4C, conduct Level II Background Checks on all personnel assigned to 4C EHS/HS/CCP sites. This shall be accomplished prior to execution of MOU.
- 5) **CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE** will provide **4C** with a certification letter that all such criminal background screenings that comply with Federal, State and local law.
- 6) CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE will not use or disclose any information concerning a recipient of services under this MOU for any purpose not in conformity with state and federal laws, or regulations except under written consent of recipient, or his responsible parent or guardian when authorized by law.

- 7) Provide approved personnel to work with 4C site supervisor in developing a schedule of service dates for each site.
- 8) Provide approved personnel to work at each site to set up and provide medical services.
- 9) Leave each site clean and in its original form after each medical session.

4C AGREES:

- 1) 4C agrees to allow CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE to provide medical services to parent(s) or guardians and children of 4C EHS/HS/CCP at listed sites on ATTACHMENT 1 under the following conditions:
- CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE cannot be on the discriminatory vendor list pursuant to **Section** 287.134, F.S.
- **CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE** cannot be debarred or suspended or otherwise determined to be ineligible to receive federal and /or state funds by an action of any governmental agency.
- CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE previous contracts (s) with 4C or any State of Florida or state affiliated agency cannot have been previously terminated for cause.
- CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE'S name cannot appear on the convicted vendor list.
- CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE must obtain parent(s) and or guardian(s) permission for each child prior to providing medical services.
- CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE'S will not use 4C staff for any form of collection of payment from parent or guardian receiving services.

4C AND CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE AGREE:

- 1) Indemnification: CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE shall be liable for and shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the AGENCY and all of its officers, agents, and employees from all claims, suits, judgments, or damages consequential or otherwise and including attorneys' fees and costs, to the extent caused by any act, actions, neglect, or omissions by CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE, its agents, or employees during the performance or operation of this MOU or any subsequent modifications thereof, whether direct or indirect, and whether to any person or tangible or intangible property.
- 2) Assignment: To neither assign the responsibility of this MOU to another party nor subcontract for any of the work contemplated under this MOU without prior written approval of 4C, which shall not be unreasonably withheld. Any sub-license, assignment or transfer otherwise occurring shall be null and void.
- 3) In the performance of this MOU, it is agreed between the parties that CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE is an independent contractor and that CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE is solely liable for the performance of all tasks contemplated by this MOU, which are not the exclusive responsibility of 4C.
- 4) CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE, its officers, agents, employees, subcontractors, or assignees, in performance of this MOU shall act in the capacity of an independent contractor and not as an officer, employee, or agent of 4C. Nor shall CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE represent to others that

- it has other compensation of 4C employment as a result of performing the duties and obligations of this MOU.
- 5) Neither CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE, its officers, agents, employees, subcontractors, nor assignees are entitled to 4C retirement or leave benefits, or to any other benefits of 4C employment as a result of performing the duties and obligations of this MOU.
- 6) CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE agrees to take such actions as may be necessary to require that each subcontractor of CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE will be deemed to be an independent contractor and will not be considered or permitted to be an agent, servant, joint venture or partner of 4C.
- 7) Unless justified by **CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE** and agreed to by **4C**, **4C** will not furnish services of support (e.g. office space, office supplies, telephone service, secretarial, or clerical support) to **CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE**, to its subcontractor or assignee.
- 8) All deductions for social security, withholding taxes, contributions to unemployment compensation funds, and all necessary insurance for **CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE**, officers, employees, agents, subcontractors, or assignees shall be the responsibility of **CAMBRIDGE INSTITUTE**.
- 9) **Termination:** This **MOU** may be terminated by either party, with or without cause, upon no less than thirty (30) calendar days' notice, in writing to the other party, unless a lesser time is mutually agreed upon in writing by both parties. Said notice shall be delivered by certified mail, return receipt requested, or in person with proof of delivery.
- 10) Venue for Dispute resolution: Venue for the interpretation and enforcement of this agreement and for the resolution of any disputes shall lie only in Orange County, Florida.
- 11) Governing Law: This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Florida.
- 12) **Mediation:** All controversies, claims, and other matters in question between the parties arising out of or relating to this contract or its breach shall be settled as follows:
 - The parties will have thirty (30) days from the date a dispute arises between them to attempt to resolve this matter through mediation. The parties agree to cooperate in implementing this procedure. However, either party may withdraw at any time from dispute resolution upon written notice to the other party and pursue other legal remedies.
 - Mediation: "Mediation" is a process in which the parties attempt to resolve a dispute by submitting their dispute to an impartial mediator who facilitates the resolution by mediation of the dispute, but who is not empowered to impose settlement on the parties. The mediation will be conducted in accordance with mediation provisions of Chapter 44, Florida Statutes.
 - The mediator will be a mediator certified by the State of Florida Supreme Court in compliance with Chapter 44, Florida Statues. The parties will equally divide the mediation fee, if any.

There are no provisions, terms, conditions or obligations other than those contained herein, and this MOU shall super cede all previous communications, representations, or agreements, either verbal or written, between the parties. It any term or provision of the contract is found to be illegal or unenforceable, the remainder of the MOU shall remain in full force and effect, and such term or provision shall be stricken.
