Who We Are & What We Do

For pregnant women, the Maternal Home Visiting program is the first step to enrolling your unborn baby into the 4C Early Head Start child care program. Weekly, 90 minute home visits are provided to income eligible pregnant women and their families. Dedicated staff will deliver prenatal information and support while partnering with you to develop and reach goals that are important to you. After your baby is born, we continue to provide in home services as we partner with 4C staff to assist with a smooth transition into the Early Head Start program.
