### 2017 PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- 16,769 children participated in the School Readiness program
- 31,549 children participated in the Voluntary Pre-K program  
\*period reported: 1/1/17- 12/31/17- includes portions of two academic years
- 9,125 students attended 437 state mandated instructor-led classes  
\*period reported: 7/1/17- 6/30/18
- 2,073 volunteers provided 76,192 hours of service  
\*period reported: 7/1/17- 6/30/18
- 4,468,057 meals were provided through the Child Care Food Program
- 4C Head Start services:  
Head Start - 436 children  
Early Head Start - 225 children  
Early Head Start Child Care Partnership Program - 280 children
- 4C served as management/fiscal agent for 13 Neighborhood Centers for Families under the Citizens' Commission for Children

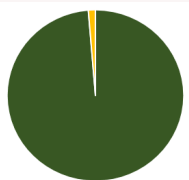
