


TRAUMA-INFORMED CARE FOR CHILD CARE PROGRAM DIRECTORS

The Department of Children and Families Office of Child Care Regulation is offering an instructor-led course, Trauma-Informed Care for Child Care Program Directors. The goal of the course is to assist child care programs in implementing trauma-informed care for the families they serve. This is a multisession course, which will require the completion of outside assignments and readings. This is an Instructor-led.



40-Hour course. Course Structure:

- Attend 5 instructor-led sessions
- 4 20 hours of observation in a classroom
- Read assigned chapters of the textbook
- Complete assigned homework.
