Water Safety Tips for a Fun & Safe Summer

Supervision is Key

Always stay within arm's reach of young children around water — even if they know how to swim. Drowning can happen quickly and quietly, so active supervision is the best defense!

Teach Kids About Water Rules

Help children understand the importance of walking (not running!) near pools, waiting for an adult before entering the water, and never swimming alone.

Life Jackets Save Lives

If your child can't swim confidently, make sure they wear a properly fitted U.S. Coast Guard-approved life jacket when near lakes, rivers, or open water.

Secure Home Pools

If you have a pool at home, be sure it's fenced on all sides with self-latching gates. Remove toys from the pool area when not in use to avoid tempting little ones.

Learn CPR

Knowing CPR can make all the difference in an emergency. Many community centers offer affordable classes for parents and caregivers.
